Settlement set in rate case

WASHINGTON (UPI) — The Federal Power Commission Wednesday approved settlement of a gas rate case to provide a 22-month freeze on higher rates served by El Paso Natural Gas Co.'s Pacific Northwest Division. The higher rates moratorium does not apply to two utility customers of the firm in Utah and Colorado which are served under a special rate, the FPC said. The FPC said the firm, based in El Paso, Tex., will continue its present rates until Nov. 1, 1965 for customers in Colorado, Idaho, Oregon, Washington and Wyoming. The case involves a rate increase application made in 1957 by the Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corp., which was later merged into El Paso.
