MADRAS — A new voting precinct in Jefferson county was created by the Jefferson county court at its January meeting when a precinct to be known as Central Number 21 was formed by splitting the old Round Butte precinct. Addition of the new precinct brings the total in the county to 13. Present registrations indicate there will be about 200 voters in the new precinct which will embrace an area just south of Madras.

Supervisors will be elected to fill the expiring term of Willis Nartz and the unexpired term of Tommy Norton.

1963 was wetter for Madras area

MADRAS — Jefferson county weather in 1963 failed to reach the extremes of temperature reported in 1962 but total precipitation recorded revealed that 1963 was a bit wetter than the previous year, a review of year-end weather records revealed this week. Compilation of weather records revealed a total of 11.28 inches of precipitation during the past year as compared to 10.82 the previous year. Never during 1963 did the mercury drop as low or rise as high as it did in 1962. Maximum reading in 1962 was 105 and the minimum a minus 27 degrees. Hottest reading during 1963 was 94 and coldest was eight degrees below zero. Below freezing temperatures were recorded during nine of the 12 months of 1963.
