

Nixon entered in N.H. voting

CONCORD, N.H. (UPI)—Former Vice President Richard M. Nixon today was entered formally in the New Hampshire presidential primary March 10. John L. MacDonald, a prominent Manchester Republican, filed his candidacy as a delegate at large favoring Nixon. Nixon's consent is not needed. MacDonald called Nixon "the outstanding leader in Republican circles and the one man to best unite the various factions that exist within the party today."

New York Gov. Nelson A. Rockefeller and Sen. Barry Goldwater of Arizona already have entered the primary preferential poll. Voters ballot directly for candidates of their choice in the preferential poll.
