

Six duel meets on weekend mat card

A full card of high school wrestling is on the docket for this weekend, with defending district champion Prineville seemingly taking on all comers.

Prineville is in the spotlight. Coach Bill Yingling's Cowboy matmen are the one aggregation in Central Oregon that is destined to go somewhere in the state meet this spring.

Prineville has demonstrated this in all its dual meets. Before state, however, the Cowboys must defend their district crown in the district tourney two weeks from now in La Grande.

Endurance Test

This weekend will demand that the Prineville grunts and groan artists be at the peak of their endurance. Tonight and Saturday offers the Cowboys nothing but wrestling.

Three duels are on the card. Tonight it's the powerful Redmond Panthers at Prineville. Up until about mid-season Redmond was regarded as a serious threat to Prineville supremacy. Prineville took Redmond by a healthy margin in an earlier duel. Redmond followed with a loss to Bend later. Though Redmond still looks to be the top choice to replace Prineville, the

odds now are against the Panthers' doing so.

Prineville is favored to take Redmond, again. Action starts at 7.

Two Duels

Tomorrow, it's a double bill. Prineville will be at Klamath Falls, facing Henley in the afternoon and Klamath Union in the evening. Prineville is rated the favorite's role in the former, but may lose the latter.

Klamath Union has been one of the wrestling hot spots in Oregon for years. The KU Pels have won their share of state titles, and have placed well at state in years they have not won it.

While the two Central Oregon mat giants are having it out at Prineville Friday, The Dalles' up-and-coming Indians are at Madras. Bend, much improved over last year but shy on depth, hosts La Grande, the mat power from the east.

Bend will have its hands full. La Grande must rule the favoring, as the visiting Tigers rank along with Redmond and Prineville in the coming district showdown. Mat time for Bend and La Grande is 7.

Tomorrow night, La Grande moves over to Redmond for a matinee mat feature. Redmond and La Grande will start scrapping at 1. It's a tossup.
