Crater Lake post
goes to Nelson

Appointment of Richard A.
Nelson, assistant superintendent
of Yellowstone National Park,
Wyoming, to superintendent of
Crater Lake National Park was
announced today by the Nation-
al Park Service regional direc-
tor, Edward A. Hummel.

Nelson's career with the Na-
tional Park Service began in
1931 at Glacier National Park.
In 1937 he was promoted from
management assistant at Glac-
ier to programs analyst in the
Northeast Regional Office in
Philadelphia. Prior to his
transfer to Yellowstone in 1962
Nelson was Chief Park Ranger
at Everglades National Park for
more than two years.

He studied forestry and bot-
any at Montana State College
and the University of Montana.
Later he completed the school
for Administrative Leadership at
Montana State University and
completed numerous in-service
training courses.

Nelson succeeds W. Ward Ye-
ager, who recently retired.

CLOSURES DUE

SALEM (UPI) — Closed fire
season regulations will go into
effect at midnight in eight more
forest and rangeland areas, for-
estry officials announced today.
Burning permits will be re-
quired in the Walker Range,
Klamath and Southwest Oregon
districts, Fremont, Winema and
Rogue River National Forests,
the Josephine County section of
the Siskiyou National Forest,
and the Lakeview Grazing Dis-
trict.

Jobs for youth
to be discussed
by church women

Employment for youth, a
problem which has local signifi-
cance, will be emphasized at
the annual May Fellowship Day
program Friday at 2 p.m. at
First Christian Church. The pro-
gram is sponsored by United
Church Women of Bend, with
everyone interested invited to at-
tend.

The nation-wide theme, free-
dom of employment and resi-
dence opportunity, has been lo-
calized to provide an opportunity
to review an area of the subject
which is of immediate concern
in Central Oregon.

In preparation for the pro-
gram, groups in several Bend
churches have studied the gen-
eral subject, including the civil
rights bill and race discrimina-
tion.

Speakers for the local pro-
gram are Willard Hollenbeck of
the local office of Oregon Em-
ployment Service; Bert Hagen,
mill official and school board
member, and Larry Dale, coun-
sellor at Bend High School.

Among areas to be covered
are dropouts and technical train-
ing in high school, education as
preparation for life, and em-
ployment data such as the num-
erical relation of jobs to ap-
licants, and apprenticeship op-
portunities.
