

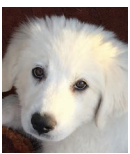

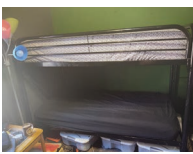

You are hereby required to appear personally before the above-entitled Court for the County of Coos, State of Oregon, at the Courthouse in Coquille in said County, in connection with the above-entitled Juvenile Court proceeding in which it is alleged that said child is within the jurisdiction of the Court by reason of the petition and/or motion attached hereto and incorporated by

reference. If the petition alleges physical or sexual abuse, the court may require the alleged perpetrator to move from the household in which the child resides. The hearing will be held at: COOS COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT, COURTHOUSE, 250 N. BAXTER ST. COQUILLE, OREGON, ON THE 15th DAY OF March 2021, AT THE HOUR OF 8:15 A.M. Failure to appear may result in the court taking jurisdiction of the child and making orders and taking actions authorized by the law.

NOTICE: READ THESE PAPERS CAREFULLY!!

A petition has been filed to establish jurisdiction under ORS 419B.100. A copy of the petition is attached. No later than 30 days from the date the petition is filed, each person about whom allegations have been made in the petition must admit or deny the allegations. Unless directed otherwise above, the admission or denial may be made orally at the hearing. If you do not appear as directed above, or do not appear at any subsequent court-ordered hearing, the Court may proceed without further notice and take jurisdiction of the child(ren) either on the date specified in this summons or on a future date, and make such orders and take such action as authorized by law including, but not limited to, establishing wardship over the child, ordering the removal of the child(ren) from the legal and physical custody of the parent(s) and guardian(s) and, restraining you from having

contact with, or attempting to contact, the child(ren) and requiring you to move from the household in which the child(ren) resides (reside) if there are allegations of physical or sexual abuse. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

You have a right to be represented by an attorney. If you wish to be represented by an attorney, please retain one as soon as possible to represent you in this proceeding. If you are the child or the parent or legal guardian of the child and you cannot afford to hire an attorney and you meet the state's financial guidelines, you are entitled to have an attorney appointed for you at state expense. To request appointment of an attorney to represent you at state expense, you must contact the juvenile court immediately. Phone 541-396-4077 for further information. If you are represented by an attorney, it is your responsibility to maintain contact with your attorney and to keep your attorney advised of your whereabouts. If you are a parent or other person legally obligated to support the child(ren), you have the obligation to support the child(ren). You may be required to pay for compensation and reasonable expenses for the child(ren)'s attorney. You may be required to pay support for the child(ren) while the child(ren) is (are) in state financed or state supported custody. You may be

required to pay other costs that arise from the child(ren) being in the jurisdiction of the Court. If you are ordered to pay for the child(ren)'s support or there is an existing order of support from a divorce or other proceeding, that support order may be assigned to the state to apply to the costs of the child(ren)'s care.

If this summons requires you to appear before the court to admit or deny the allegations of the petition or requires you to file a written answer to the petition and you contest the petition, the court will schedule a hearing on the allegations of the petition and order you to appear personally and may schedule other hearings related to the petition and order you to appear personally. If you are ordered to appear, you must appear personally in the courtroom, unless the court has granted you an exception in advance under ORS 419B.918 to appear by other means including, but not limited to, telephonic or other electronic means. If you are represented by an attorney you must appear personally at any hearing where you have been ordered or summoned to appear. "Appear personally" requires your presence at court - you MAY NOT appear through an attorney, unless you are the child at issue.

If your rights are adversely affected by the court's judgment or decision regarding jurisdiction or disposition, you have the right to appeal under ORS 419A.200. If you decide to appeal a judgment or decision of the court, you must file a notice of

appeal no later than 30 days after the entry of the court's judgment or decision as provided in ORS 419A.200. You have a right to be represented by an attorney in an appeal under ORS 419A.200. If you are the child or the parent or legal guardian of the child and you cannot afford to hire an attorney and you meet the state's financial guidelines, you are entitled to have an attorney appointed for you at state expense. To request appointment of an attorney to represent you at state expense in an appeal under ORS 419A.200, you must contact the juvenile court immediately. Phone 541-396-4077 for further information.

The Department of Labor (DOL) has certified PCC Structural - Redmond for the Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) program. This certification is the result of PCC Structural's production of complex investment castings being determined adversely affected by import competition or shifts in production to a foreign country. If you were laid off due to a lack of work on or after 7/7/2019, you may be eligible for the following benefits and services under

the TAA program: Re-Employment Assistance Training (On-the-Job, Classroom, or Apprenticeship) Job Search Allowances Relocation Allowances Additional Unemployment Insurance benefits in the form of Trade Readjustment Allowances (TRA) Wage subsidy for workers 50 and older Health Coverage Tax Credit (HCTC)

* Important Deadlines to Receive Benefits and Services * To be eligible for TRA, you must be enrolled in training within 26 weeks after your most recent layoff from the adversely affected employer or 26 weeks after the Trade Act certification, whichever

is later. If you can't get into approved training by these deadlines, a waiver of training may be available to you.

The Trade Act program also offers other re-employment services that have deadlines attached. Job Search allowance - 365 days from the certification date or your most recent qualifying separation date. If you are in training that takes you beyond the above deadline, you have 182 days from the date you complete training to access this service.

Relocation allowance - 425 days from the certification date or your most recent qualifying separation date. If you are in training that takes you beyond the above deadline, you have 182 days from the date you complete training to access this service.
