**Hsu's late eagle creates big swing in first career LPGA win** — Wei-Ling Hsu promised her caddie she wouldn't cry if, or when, she finally won. She was mistaken. Hsu eagled the par-5 15th hole Sunday, creating a four-shot swing that gave her a two-shot lead, and won the LPGA Tour's Pure Silk Championship for her first career victory. "At 15, ... I thought about myself, that I've been waiting for seven years. I don't want to wait any, more," a tearful Hsu said on the green after securing the victory with a par. Later, after some time to let it soak in? "I think this is the happiest day ever. How do you cry?" she said. "And somehow, I just cried so hard the last hole, but I feel happy. Just happy." Hsu closed with a 3-under 68 to finish at 13-under 271, two shots clear of playing partner Moriya Jutanugarn. Jutanugarn had a 70. Jessica Korda was third at 10 under after a 70.

**Walk-off single sends Oregon past Texas; play winner-take-all finale** — Haley Cruse hit a leadoff double and two batters later, Terra McGowan drove her in with a walk-off single to right as the Ducks topped the No. 12 seed Longhorns, 3-2 in eight innings, in the first game of an NCAA regional final at McCombs Field Sunday night in Austin, Texas. Oregon and Texas played a second time, for the right to play a Super Regional, late Sunday night.

Never mind that he was No. 115 in the world. "This is just an incredible feeling because I believed it was possible, but everything was saying it wasn't," Mickelson said.

Julius Boros for 53 years held the distinction of golf's oldest major champion. He was 48 when he won the 1968 PGA Championship in San Antonio.

The record now belongs to Mickelson, whose legacy is as much rooted in longevity as any of the skills that have made him among the most exciting players in the game.

Mickelson became the 10th player to win majors in three decades, an elite list that starts with Harry Vardon and was most recently achieved by Tiger Woods.

Woods, who won the Masters in 2019 at age 43 after four back surgeries, was among to send a tweet of congratulations.

Three months after 43-year-old Tom Brady won a seventh Super Bowl, Mickelson added to this year of ageless wonders.

Mickelson became the first player in PGA Tour history to win tournaments 30 years apart. The first of his 45 titles was in 1991 when he was still a junior at Arizona State.

"He's been on tour as long as I've been alive," Jon Rahm said. "For him to keep that willingness to play and compete and practice, it's truly admirable."
