Djokovic, Nadal, Federer grouped in same half at French Open

BY HOWARD FENDRICH AP Tennis Writer Well, here's a new one for the Big Three of men's tennis: Novak Djokovic, Rafael Nadal and Roger Federer ended up in the same half of the French Open field.
