Daily Bridge Club Simple Saturday

"Simple Saturday" columns are meant to improve basic technique and logical thinking.

Defenders are supposed to observe a host of "rules" — for instance, "third hand high" — that are really only tendencies. One guideline worth following: Let declarer win his first try at a repeatable finesse.

At today's 3NT, South leads a diamond to dummy's jack at the second trick. Suppose East takes the king and returns a heart. Declarer wins, takes the A-Q of diamonds and concedes a diamond. He has nine tricks: three diamonds, three hearts, a spade and two clubs.

EIGHT TRICKS

Let East duck the first diamond. South will surely return to his hand for a second diamond finesse, and then East wins. South can't reach dummy to set up the fifth diamond and get back to cash it. He could still succeed but will probably go down.

Declarer could (and should, at IMPs or party bridge) prevail by playing low from dummy on the first diamond, preserving an entry to dummy. That play wouldn't occur to most declarers.

DAILY QUESTION

You hold: ♠ K Q 7 2 ♥ J 10 9 8 5 ♦ 10 8 ♣ Q 5. Your partner opens

one club, you respond one heart, he bids one spade and you raise to two spades. Partner then bids three diamonds. What do you say?

ANSWER: Partner's diamonds is a try for game and asks you to consider whether you have useful cards. Since you have excellent spade support, a "working" queen of clubs and only a wasted jack in hearts opposite partner's shortness, jump to four spades.
