Daily Bridge Club Eights and tens

"I sat in on a lecture you gave last week," Cy the Cynic told me. "You treated 'eight ever, nine never.'

'I mentioned that it's a poor guide," I said. "Even if you have nine cards in a suit missing the queen, to finesse in one direction or the other is only slightly inferior."

'Suppose you have a 10-card holding," Cy said.

"You must be kidding," I protested. With a guffaw, Cy produced today's deal.

'South played at 3NT," he said, "and West led a spade. South won the third spade and then took the ace of diamonds, following your advice.

EIGHT TRICKS

"When East discarded, South came back to his hand and led the jack of diamonds, but West covered. South had to take the king and win the next two diamonds in his hand. He never got dummy's last two diamonds and went down. So much for your '10

I had to give Cy credit. At Trick Four, South must let the jack of diamonds ride. No matter how the suit lies, South can avoid the blockage and win at least nine tricks.

DAILY QUESTION

You hold: ♠ K J 8 6 2 ♥ K 7 5 ♦ Q 8 3 ♣ 9 4. The dealer, at your left, opens three diamonds. Your partner doubles, and the next player passes. What do you say?

ANSWER: Partner's double is for takeout. He has a hand worth 17 or more points with support for the unbid suits, or maybe a stronger hand with a suit he intends to show. Your queen of diamonds is surely a wasted card for offense. Nevertheless, your hand is worth a jump to four spades.
