We're in for a hot one with temps in the triple digits — see our news coverage today starting on Page A1.

For the outdoor enthusiasts among us, it's time to escape to the higher elevations to get a few degrees cooler. With plenty of lakes, forest trails, cold streams and rivers and even snow lingering on the mountains, there are lots of places to beat the heat. Remember, if a trailhead or day use area is full, have a backup plan and only park in designated areas. A few of the higher, more-well-loved trailheads also require the Central Cascades Wilderness Permit, so make sure you snag yours before your trip up.

HIKING AND DAY USE SITES

Deschutes National Forest

- Black Crater Trailhead: Open; likely patchy snow at top

Lucky Lake Trailhead: Open; snow free with light deadfall, deep snow beyond lake toward Williamson Mountain
Many Lakes Trailhead: Open; snow free with moderate breakdown, not recommended for stock
