

HAWAIIANS AROUSED.

Seattle, Wash., Sept. 4.—H. M. Whitty, ex-postmaster general of the Hawaiian islands, who has just arrived from Honolulu, reports a strong revival of the annexation feeling on the islands and says it is greatly intensified through the belief that should Hawaii be annexed to United States the threatened Japanese trouble would be entirely wiped out by the abrogation of all existing treaties.

By what is known as the Gibson treaty, entered into with Japan about 13 years ago, Japanese may pour into the islands in unlimited number. They now number 25,000, and are coming, Whitney stated, at the alarming rate of 2000 per
