

Wiped out by Insurgents.

Key West, Fla., Sept. 24—Ad- vices from Havana last night per steamer Mascotte state that, late on Monday afternoon 87 Spanish troops started for Calabazara, eight miles from Havana. On Tuesday morning five of the 87 returned to Havana and reported that their companions had been killed by in- surgents shortly before reaching Calabazara.

The Spaniards said they were surrounded by about 200 insurgents who poured in one volley and then charged with machetes. The five who returned were badly wounded and were left for dead by the Cu- bans

On hearing the story a Spanish regiment was sent to the scene, and the bodies of the 82 Spaniards were found in a heap. The wounds made by the machetes were fright- ful, several of the Spaniards having been beheaded. The captain was killed in this manner. Captain- General Weyler has issued orders to newspapers not to publish a word about the tragedy

This morning five prisoners were executed, two garroted and three shot. Two thousand people, mostly Spanish officers and their wives witnessed the execution

A WHITECAP OUTRAGE.

Toledo, O., Sept. 20.—The white- caps have created another sensa- tion in this county by whipping a man named Huntsman, who lives at Holland station, ten miles from here, and burying him alive. Ac- cording to report, the story has only just leaked out although the outrage was committed September 9. The family was under threats and afraid to communicate to the au- thorities the story, but neighbor- learned of the facts, and informed the police today.

The facts, as reported to the pol- ice, are that two of the Huntsman- children, coming from the post office, were picked up on the road by two men in a buggy and accus- ed of stealing a pocket book contain-

ing \$80. The next night, a party of men came to the Huntsman house, and, after calling Huntsman out of bed, seized and dragged him outside and beat him and misused him in a frightful manner. Then they carried him to a grave, and, putting him in it, covered him with earth.

After awhile, they dug him up gain. They beat and abused him a second time, and finally buried him again. Then they dug him up the second time and again lashed him and then drove away. The two children were also lashed. The affair occurred about midnight. Huntsman is a respectable, well-to- do farmer.
