

Although 52 years old, he had to ask his mother's permission, which being granted, he started across country after the bears.

> "Some of the natives of Kodiak use fire-arms on their hunting expeditions, but this fellow simply armed himself with a long spear. He greased his head and got to wind --ward of the animals. He dug a hole in the ground, planted one end of the spear firmly with the point in the direction of the bear and crouched down. The bear came along and licked the head of the Indian. With a swift and dextrous movement the native cut a gash in the bear's neck with the sharp spear point. The angered animal drew back a few yards and made a rush. He impaled himself on the spear point, and all was over."
