

ANOTHER STRONG BOY.

During recent years a good many young men have devoted themselves to the development of their muscles purely for the purpose of testing the possibilities of human strength. In this line of endeavor no one has been more successful than Max Unger of New York city, to whose remarkable feats the notice of the public has been recently attracted. Even Sandow, who has for some years past stood at the head of his class, is not so sure of his laurels since Unger has come to the front. He does not compare with Sandow in the massiveness of his muscle, for there is still discernible in his figure the slimness of youth, and yet his development is so gigantic that when you see him stripped you wonder how so heavily muscled a man could possibly squeeze into the clothes in which you had previously seen him.

Unger's measurements are superb. With a height of 5 feet 10 inches and a weight of 165 pounds, he has a chest measuring 40 inches that expands to 48 inches under a full breath. His neck is 18 inches in circumference, and he is 51 1/2 inches across the shoulders. His thigh measures 25 1/2 inches and his calf 16, while his fore-arm has a girth of 14 inches and his biceps one of 16 1/2. His age is 17 years.

The feats he performs are when his youthfulness is considered, little less than marvelous. With a weight of 203 pounds on his back he walks about the gymnasium with apparent ease. In a stationary position he has supported on his shoulders 1,250 pounds. He tosses about great weights with the apparent ease of a child playing jack-stones. He approaches a giant dumbbell that weighs 180 pounds, picks it up easily, balances it in one hand and raises it aloft as far as his arm can reach. These and dozens of other equally astonishing things he accomplishes with seemingly little effort.
