Finished the Work.

SALEM, Dec. 30.—The members of the state board of equalization drew as much of their pay as they could get today and adjourned sine die.

The salary and mileage the members of the board allowed themselves for the 39 day session are as follows:

Auldon, of Lake county, \$388 80; Walker, of Coos county, \$360; Gibson, Polk county, \$300; Thompson, Multnomah county, \$310 60; Wingate, Clatsop county, \$330 60; Wells, Crook county, \$353; Goodall, Union county, \$374 60; Holland, Malheur county, \$402 60. The total expenses on account of the members is \$3162 60. In Marion county the board declared \$1 worth \$1 30. If the members had accepted pay in this kind of money their pay would have been only \$2432 76. The pay of Secretary Wells was \$301 50; Clerk, G. G. Shivley, \$301 50; Page H. Holman, \$75 37. Total, \$3840 97. The amount in the fund at the beginning of the session was \$2925 70. This was divided pro rata among the members and clerical force. The deficit to be reported to the next legislature is \$895 27.

D. P. Thompson offered his resolution to abolish the board, and to have the equalizing done by the governor, secretary of state and treasurer, and to reduce the pay of the members; but it found no favor with the board.

The report of the committee on legislation recommended that the classification of property be extended; that a definite time be fixed so that all rolls must be in the hands of the secretary of state; that sheriffs' tax rolls be added to the assessment each year as a basis upon which to make state taxes; that changes made by the state board apply only to state taxes without interfering with county business.

The assessment for this county was changed from \$1,874,457 to \$1,920,539. The board raised all most every county in the state, raising Multnomah \$7,964,065.

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
