#### Senator Gowan L cates the long-Missing Wave of Prosperity.

"A wave of prosperity has struck Harney county,"said Senator A. W. says the Oregonian of June 9.

"The Hanley brothers, principal cattle-buyers and shippers of that country, are paying from \$3 to \$5 more a head for cattle than has been paid in the past ten years. Two-year old steers bring from \$23 to \$25, and the matured stock from \$30 to \$35, and others prices are in proportion. There are many Eastern cattlemen, from St. Louis, Omaha. Chicago and Minneapolis in the Harnev country, competing with each other, and every stage More cattle are now being shipped 6, 1897. out of the Malheur and Harney countries than during the past four years. Interest is so great that stockmen living in Harney are now purse in Southern Oregon, buying large herds and driving them home across country.
