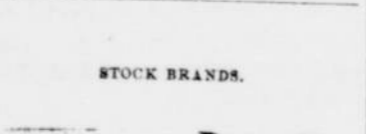

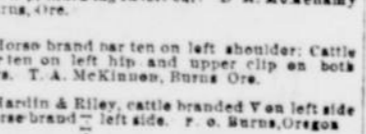

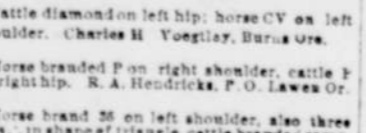
FREE BRAND COWS. Horse brand on left side, cattle brand on left hip, marks tag in left ear. D. M. McMenamy Burns, Ore.



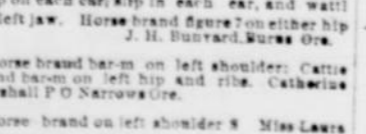
Horse brand on left hip and upper clip on both ears. T. A. McKinnon, Burns Ore.



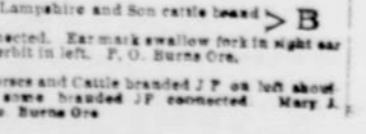
Hardin & Riley, cattle branded on left side horse brand on left side. T. O. Burns, Oregon.
