Horse brand on left side, cattle brand on left hip, marking in left ear. F. W. McKinnon, Burns Ore.

J. C. Foley, cattle brand on right side, horse brand on left shoulder.

Horse brand on left side, cattle brand on left hip, marking in left ear. F. O. Burns Ore.

Cattle brand on left hip; horse on left shoulder. Charles H. Ventry, Burns Ore.

Horse brand on right shoulder, cattle on right hip. K. A. Hendricks, P. O. Lawton Ore.

Horse brand on left shoulder, also three dots in shape of triangle, cattle brand on left hip. E. K. Grant, Burns Ore.

J. P. Dickenson cattle brand J P connected on left hip. Horse brand on left side, F. O. Burns Ore.

Cattle brand figure 2 on either hip, mark light crop of each ear, clip in each ear, and wall on left jaw. Horse brand figure on either hip. J. H. Bryant, Burns Ore.

Horse brand on left shoulder, cattle brand on left hip and side. Cattle brand Marshall P. O. Narrows Ore.

Horse brand on left shoulder S. M. Lewis Wash Hill, Burns Ore.

Horse brand on left shoulder and same on muscle of right hind leg. F. H. Smith Burns Ore.

S. Lathrop and Son cattle brand B connected. Farm mark swallow fork in right ear. F. O. Burns Ore.

Horse and cattle brand J P on left shoulder, horse brand J P on right. Burns Ore.
