Manila, Feb. 23, 3 a. m-Immense damage has been done by fires which are believed to have been started by insurgents last night. The fire department has experienced great difficulty in fighting the flames owing to defective apparatus. It is reported that the natives have damaged the appara- Burns

There was some fighting in the streets during the night but the Americans quickly quelled the uprising. A number of insurgents were killed and several Americans soldiers wounded

A large market place was among the first to burn. Between 600 and 700 residences and business houses have been destroyed. Fires were started at several points simultaneously and spread with great rapidity, resisting all efforts to control them. Hundreds of homeless native are huddled in the streets, making patrol duty of the Americans very difficult.


