The officers connected with the forest reserves of the Northwest are continually trying to create a sentiment favorable to the policy of the present administration and insist that the people are favorable to the system when in fact few are in sympathy with the policy.

Locally it works a hardship because of the fact that the supervisor of the district is, or seems at least, indifferent to the interests of the stockmen. In one instance where a local stockman failed to get a permit for the season just closed, simply because he had not received any notice whatever that such was necessary and was entirely ignorant of the ruling of the Department, he was charged double the regular grazing fee as a penalty and allowed a permit for only 50 head.

The Times-Herald would like to see local stockmen stand up for their rights and ask the forestry department where it gets authority to charge a grazing fee. Judge Whiston of the district court of Washington recently decided that no departmental head could make such grazing charges without first getting authority from congress.

The forest reserve policy is becoming "fierce." The withdrawals are not confined to forests but include much strictly grazing land with practically no timber. It may be a good policy, but we fail to see the advantage when it is practically ruining the only industry of a big, isolated country.
