SUPT. RIBBY EXPLAINS.

To the Editor, Times-Herald:—In your paper of last week an article appeared signed by Thos. Bain, in which he arranges various charges against the office of County Superintendent of schools, of this county.

First he makes a statement that school funds have been misappropriated, and that school districts not in existence are drawing money from the regular apportionment, I wish to state that this is positively false, and that the public may be able to investigate intelligently I give here the method by which apportionments of school funds are made and the apportionments for the last year.

When I came into office there were 27 organized school districts in the county, since, one school district has been discontinued, and two new ones organized making at the present time 28 school districts in the county.

Below I give the apportionment list for April and October, 1906. The public can compare same with my office books, the county treasurers books, the books of the various school clerks and satisfy yourselves as to the truth of the statement made by Mr. Bain.
