"Scottie" Stakes out Claim.

Walter Scott, known to fame as "Scotty" has filed the location of his mysterious mine for which he has been drawing revenue for a number of years past. 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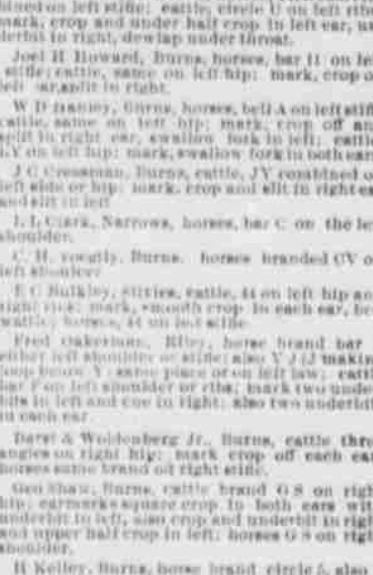
