Of Interest to Orchardists.

It is a well known fact that in this locality rabbits do not visit foot hill orchards and destroy trees. They confine their work of destruction to orchards planted on the flat lands, and for the benefit of such either of the following preventative are effectual.

First, staple to four or five laths two small wires fasten around trees, don't fasten to tree but drive two stakes in ground and fasten with fine wire to top of stakes, and top wire which is stapled to laths. These protectors are inexpensive and will last for many years.

Another given by Elijah Stans of Ohio: Take beef gall, soap and buttermilk. Make them into a paste thick enough to be easily applied with a brush. One gall mixed as directed will go over one hundred trees.

If at planting time you have pest infected trees, or weevily seed, prepare your trees by pruning back to whip, soil of top to brighten you want branches. Then place trees and peas, or any pest infected seed or plants, into a tight box, place a saucer or other shallow dish on top, pour into it a little bisulphide of carbon then close lid down tightly for 48 hours. These fumes being heavy go to the bottom, and soon the entire box becomes filled with the poisonous gas which deals death to all animal or insect life. No flame of any kind should be near where the box is placed, as gas is very explosive; and be careful to breathe none of the fumes while handling. The above is a very old remedy and sure to kill. Still I prefer the lime and sulphur properly prepared on account of its safety to handle, and with persistent application will kill every form of scale louse, even the oyster-shell louse of which we have many in this locality.

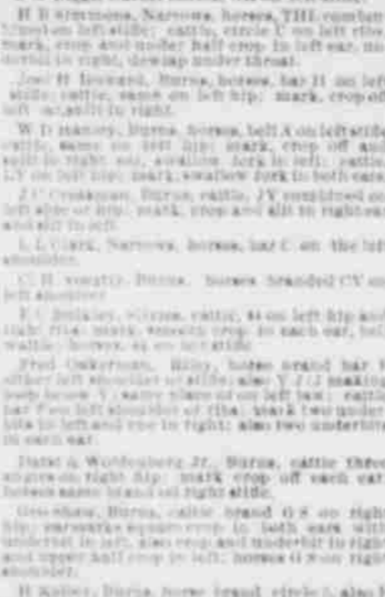
