INCREASES PRICE OF TIMBER LAND.

The Oregon's Washington correspondent has the following in a recent issue:

Beginning December 1, unreserved public timber lands entered under the timber and stone act must be paid for at its appraised value...

Under the new regulation a person desiring to make a timber entry must file his application, accompanied by an affidavit stating that he has been personally upon the land...

Within nine months the Government will undertake to make its own appraisal and, when this is done, the applicant can have the land at the Government's price...

In no instance will timber land be sold for less than \$2.50 per acre. No entryman can cut timber during the time appraisal is being made...

Last winter Secretary Garfield endeavored to persuade Congress to amend the timber and stone act so as to provide for the disposal of timber land at appraised value...
