Loganberry culture is profitable when this delicious fruit produces as it did for a fruit-grower on Mission Bottom, Marion county, yielding 12,200 lbs. to the acre last season.

The weather bureau has inaugurated a special service for the fruit districts of the state during April and May. Trained men will be placed in the chief fruit districts who will be prepared to notify fruit growers just what may be expected on frosty mornings.
