

NOTICE OF PETITION FOR AN IRRIGATION DISTRICT.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the undersigned Citizens of the United States, constituting a majority of the bona fide owners of land within the boundaries hereinafter described, or holders of uncompleted titles or contracts for purchase of State lands under the laws of the State of Oregon, or bona fide claimants to lands under the laws of the United States, being desirous of forming an irrigation district embracing the lands within the boundaries hereinafter set forth, will at the session of the County Court of Harney County, Oregon, on the 5th day of March, 1919, at 10 o'clock A. M. of said day, or so soon thereafter as the same can be heard, respectfully present to said Court a petition praying said Court to proclaim an irrigation district and defining the boundaries thereof, and to call an election for the purposes above set forth and to do all things necessary and proper under the law for the formation of said district, and designating the time and places for voting at said election.
