"Better Sires-Better Stock." This is the slogan of a national setter live-stock crusade, to get etively in motion October 1, that is announced by the United States Deartment of Agriculture, working in opperation with the State agricultural colleges and other agencies intersted in live-stock improvement. The ampuign looks forward to the future ood needs of this country's increasng population and results from long nd careful observation of the livetock indutsry in this country, and was planned after extensive consultaion with specialists and breeders, The plan is to hasten the replacement of the multitude of scrub domestic animals in the United States with pure-bred or high-bred stock. and also to improve the quality of sure breds themselves. The goal in view is greater effisiency in produc-


The campaign will be the first erganized crusade in a large country to improve all live stock simultanecusly. It will interfere in no way with any work in live-stock improvement now being conducted, but makes all the work more definite and effective by providing official recogniion for progressive breeders.

The campaign will be supervised from the Department of Agriculture n Wahsington, and in each State by the State agricultural college. Couny agents and other field workers of the Department of Agriculture and of the State colleges will handle the ampaign locally. Every live-stock wner actively cooperating and keeping and using none but pure-bred sires of good quality will be given an emblem as an official recognition of peritorious effort.
