It will be interesting to watch the career of this young man.

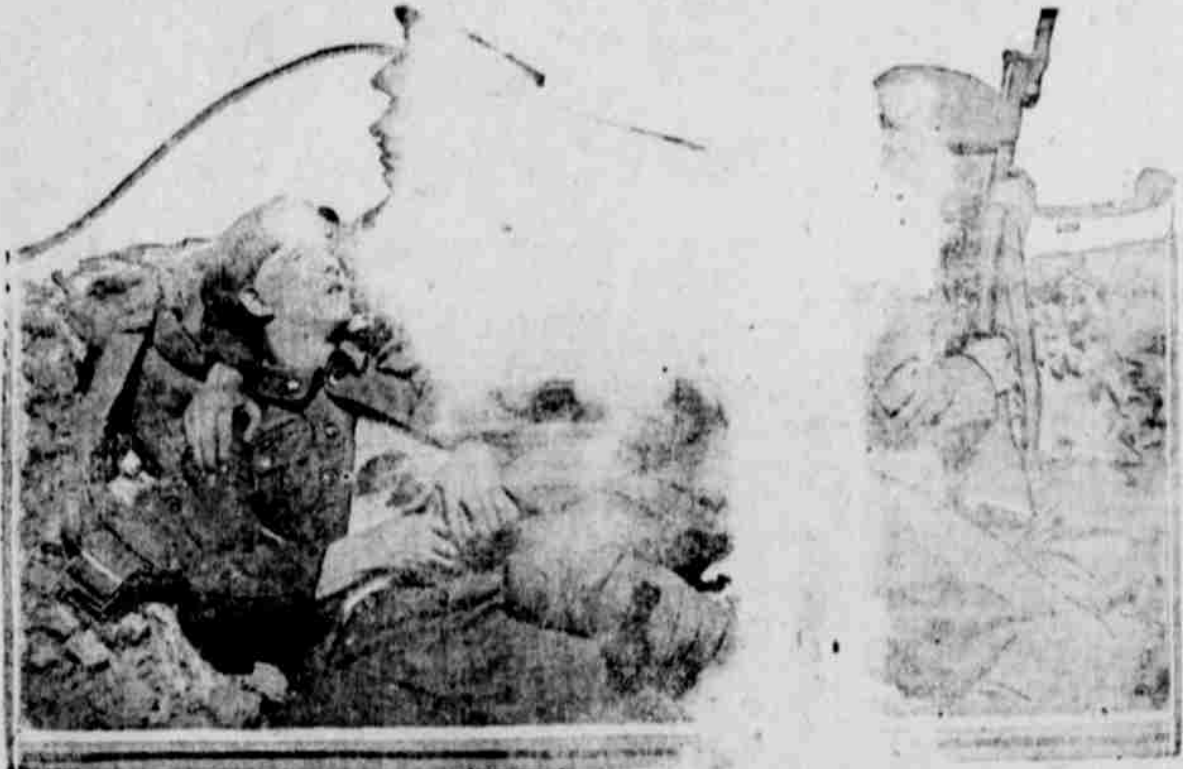
If his success continues we might have him touch the profiteer and cause him to reduce his prices to normal.
