Every person, firm, co-partnership, company or corporation residing, on, owning, leasing, occupying, possessing or having charge of or dominion over any land, building, wharf or dock infested with ground squirrels, rabbits, cut worms or grasshoppers in Harney County, Oregon is notified to begin at once to effectively exterminate and destroy all such GROUND SQUIRRELS, RABBITS, CUT WORMS AND GRASSHOPPERS.

Formulas for the preparation of instructions for mixing the poisons best adapted for the extermination of any or all of the above mentioned insects or rodents may be had free of cost by communicating with the office of the COUNTY AGRICULTURAL AGENT, at BURNS, ORE.

The COUNTY COURT has secured a large amount of Strychnine and Paris Green Oats and Bran and other ingredients necessary for the preparation of the various poison mixtures. Communities desiring these poisons may secure them in any amount desired at actual cost of the ingredients and mixing by applying to the County Agent at his office in the COMMERCIAL CLUB rooms at Burns, Ore.

If any person herein designated shall, within thirty days from the first publication of this notice, fail to begin in good faith to exterminate and destroy, according to the method aforesaid, or by any other effective means said ground squirrels, rabbits, cut worms and grasshoppers herein designated, the County Court of Harney County, Oregon will appoint a person or persons to proceed with extermination and eradication of such ground squirrels, rabbits, cut worms and grasshoppers, and the cost thereof incurred will be assessed to such land, building, wharf or dock and unless paid will become a lien against the same for the extermination of said ground squirrels, rabbits, cut worms and grasshoppers.

The most reasonable time and manner of distributing the poisons may be determined by consulting with the County Agent.
