**RANGE STOCK INDUSTRY LOOKS TO BE PERMANENT**

Western States Have Upward of Half Billion Acres Suited to No Other Profitable Use

From Department of Industrial Journalism Oregon Agricultural College.

Permanence of the range cattle and sheep industry in the eleven western states has been recognized and the state colleges, including O. A. C. are to join efforts in helping the range livestock men with some of their knotty problems. These states have an area of 650 million acres which can be used only for grazing.

More than a third of the area is public lands not under control and so badly overgrazed that users are not getting full carrying capacity. It furnishes much of the spring and fall grass and needs wiser handling.

Control of animal diseases and parasites, coordinated production and marketing, culling sheep for increasing weight of fleeces, and improving feeds and feeding are other items in the program. The situation for Oregon will be opened up in the agricultural conference to be held at the college January 21-25.

Growers, investigators and national leaders will assist in working out the program in these subjects and also for fruits and vegetables, field crops, dairy products and poultry.

After the group programs have been generally worked out they will be submitted to a general conference for coordination with all the others for a comprehensive plan of farming in Oregon.

Vice President Calvin of the Union Pacific Railroad was recently interviewed by the Portland Telegram in which he said the extension of the Central Oregon line from Crane to Burns would be pushed soon. No reference was made to the fact that the grade is ready for the rails, but that work was under the supervision of the Fred Herrick Lumber Co. It is not known just how soon the rails will be laid but it is understood this work may be done any time during the winter.

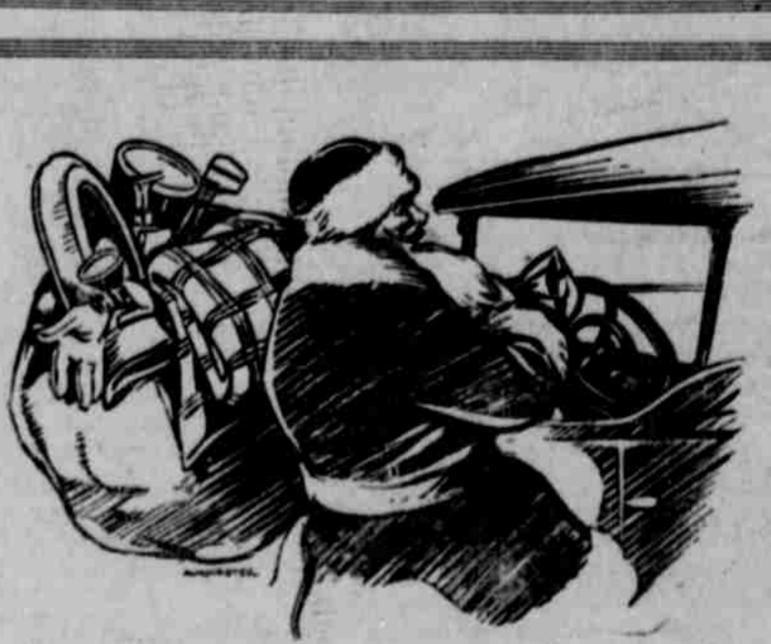
