### R. A. FORD'S RECORD

(Oregon Voter)

R. A. Ford, of Dayville, was held in such general high respect by his associates that, while he introduced but one bill, his opinions were always highly respected, he expressed them in both committees and on the floor of the House. So quiet and unassuming was Mr. Ford, his participation in any discussion usually tended to mollify disputes and adjust difficulties. His judgment was particularly deferred to in connection with matters affecting Eastern Ore-

gon highways for his past activity in promoting the John Day highway gave him considerable prestige on the House committee on Roads and Highways of which he was a member.

Mr. Ford considered every bill on its own merits without any regard as to whether or not it was an organization or "secret society" measure. He voted for abolition of prison chaplains, for taxing church hospitals; against taxing church property; against Mrs. Simmons' women jury bill and for Mrs. Simmons' bill requiring examination of both sexes

for marriage license. He voted for licensing of aliens in business and against forbidding aliens to obtain employment on public works; for classifying logged-off lands for taxation; for Carsner's salary reduction bill; for tax supervising and conservation bill; for state income tax and against property tax offset amendment to income tax.

He voted for placing assessors under state tax commission; for killing severance tax and against the bill placing state motor vehicle fees in lieu of municipal fees for operation of motor transit lines; for

creating office of state market agent and for the passage of the anti-oleo bill; against master fish warden appropriation and for the act impairing initiative and referendum.

Of sterling character, unassuming but faithful, without any but the highest principles of action. Although not as aggressive as a young man might be, his compensation was a wide respect for his sincerity and honesty of purpose.
