SEED TESTING PAYS

Seed testing saves money. A sample of clover seed recently tested by the co-operative seed testing laboratory at the experiment station carried 8.56 per cent of inert matter consisting mostly of stones. While a little larger than clover seed, the stones are of a neutral cloor and might be easily mistaken for seed unless examined very closely.

At the present prices of clover seed, farmers would be sowing 32 cents worth of stones per acre using normal rate of weeding. These data Salected by the experiment station show the value of testing seed before sowing.

Samples of seed sent to the experiment station at the Oregon Agricultural college will be tested free of charge.




