APRIL TERM, 1889. Monday and Tuesday's proceedings were published last week.

WEDNESDAY. J. T. Sillman having posted notes, deposited \$100 with county treasurer, filed his petition, and given satisfactory bond, was granted a license to sell spirituous, vinous and malt liquors, by the dram, in Burns precinct, for one year.

James H. Logan appointed Justice of the Peace for Harney precinct, to fill vacancy.

Ordered that a contract be let for building a temporary jail to cost not more than \$500. That said jail be built at Harney, the temporary county-seat of Harney county, on a lot to be designated by the court. That the Clerk give notice by publication in the EAST OREGON HERALD for three successive weeks that sealed proposals will be received by the county court, and the contract be let or rejected, as the court may deem best.

THURSDAY. Louis Racine & Cote's petition for liquor license having 62 names on it, and C. A. Sweek as attorney for them, the remonstrance of L. M. Brown and 15 others appearing only by petition, was granted for a period of one year.

Stephen Lamphire was appointed Supervisor of Road District No. 15.

FRIDAY. There being no proper place for the safe-keeping of moneys that may come into the County Treasurer's hands by virtue of his office, it was ordered that the Clerk purchase a safe of about 3400 lbs. for said Treasurer, for county purposes.

SATURDAY. Ordered that a special term of county court be held Saturday, April 27th, 1889, at 10 a. m., for consideration of letting contract for building temporary jail; furnishing benches for the temporary county buildings; renting a temporary county court house; and granting a liquor license to Paul Locher in Burns precinct.
