TOWN ORDINANCE No. 26.

Be it ordained by the town of Burns, Harney county, Oregon, by her duly elected council that the following Ordinance for the government of said town is hereby enacted.

It shall be the duty of all person owning land on second street in the town of Burns, Harney county, Oregon, upon notice of the street commissioner to build or cause to be built, a side walk in front of his or her lot or lots. Said side walk shall be eight feet wide with two inch lumber with three stringers four by six, and shall be built in a good and workman like manner and shall be on the line of the street; said side walk shall be of a uniform height along each block, and in case any person or persons fail to build such side walk within thirty days from the date of notice of the street commissioner it shall be the duty of the street commissioner to proceed to build such side walk and such work shall be deemed to have been done at the request of the owner or lawful possessor thereof and the same shall be done at the expense of the owner and in case such person or persons fail or neglect to pay for such work then the town of Burns shall have redress by an action at law for double the amount expended in building such walk or walks.
