COUNTY SEAT.

Judge Shattuck Decision in the County Seat Contest.

J W Page voted in Saddle Butte precinct and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct, but was a resident of Embree precinct.

L E Mahaffey voted in Burns precinct polling place No. 1 and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct, but was a resident of ——— precinct.

Eugene Hembree voted in Burns precinct polling place No. 4 and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct, but was a resident of ——— precinct.

T J Hellen voted in Burns precinct and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct, but was a resident of Harney precinct.

H K Long voted in Alvord precinct and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct, but was a resident of Burns precinct.

5. That one S. Stannard voted in Harney precinct for the town of Burns as such county seat, and prior to casting his ballot had accepted a bribe of money and cast his ballot for the town of Burns in pursuance of such bribe.

6. That the canvassing board of Harney County which canvassed the votes cast for county seat at said election, amongst other votes canvassed and counted for the town of Burns a ballot which was found in the ballot box of Burns precinct, polling place No. 1, marked "state and district" and designed and intended for the reception of votes cast for state officers and district officers only, which ballot was full and complete and contained the vote of the person who deposited the same for state, district, county and precinct officers and for the location of permanent county seat for said county.

7. That the following named persons voted at said election upon the question of location of permanent county seat of said county, under the following circumstances, to-wit:

Orrin Price voted in Drewsey precinct for the town of Harney as such county seat and at the time voting was not 21 years of age but was a minor.

Warren Jordan voted in Saddle Butte precinct for Silvies City and at the time of voting was not 21 years of age but was a minor.

J D Murray voted in Drewsey precinct for Silvies City and at the time of voting was not a resident of Harney county, but a resident of Malheur county.

J A Wright voted in Embree precinct for Silvies City and at the time of voting was not a resident of Harney county but was a resident of Baker county.

Charles Carroll voted in Embree precinct for the town of Harney as such county seat and at the time of voting was not a resident of Harney county or of the State of Oregon.

W J Carroll voted in Embree precinct for the town of Harney and at the time of voting was not a

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resident of Harney county but was a resident of Malheur county.

S F Sutton voted in Alvord precinct for the town of Harney and at the time of voting was not a resident of Harney county but was a resident of Malheur county.

Herman Schmidt voted in Drewsey precinct for the town of Harney and at the time of voting had not been a resident of the State of Oregon for six months prior thereto.

P E Engel voted in Harney precinct for the town of Harney and at the time of voting was not a resident of Harney county but was a resident of Grant county.

T J Cozad voted in Burns precinct polling place No. 1 for the town of Harney and at the time of voting was not a resident of Harney county but was a resident of Grant county.

Ben Cozad voted in Burns precinct No. 1 for the town of Harney and at the time of voting was not a resident of Harney County but was a resident of Grant County.

J C Buckland voted in Blitzen precinct for the town of Harney and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct, but was a resident of Harney precinct.

R F Claypool voted in Crane Creek precinct for the town of Harney and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct, but was a resident of Harney precinct.

James Brock voted in Harney precinct for Silvies City and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct, but was a residence of Saddle Butte precinct.

G W Hayes voted in Blitzen precinct polling place No. 3 for Silvies City and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct, but was a resident of Burns precinct.

James Gilbert voted in Alvord precinct for the town of Harney and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct, but was a resident of Saddle Butte precinct.

M A Modi voted in Alvord precinct for the town of Harney and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct but was a resident of Embree precinct.

Z L Thomas voted in Harney precinct for the town of Harney and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct but was a resident of Burns precinct.

J A McCune voted in Crane Creek precinct for Silvies City and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct but was a resident of Saddle Butte precinct.

E H King voted in Blitzen precinct polling place No. 4 for the town of Harney and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct but was a resident of Harney precinct.

C W Jones voted in Alvord precinct for the town of Harney and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct but was a resident of Harney precinct.

W H Gibson voted in Harney precinct for the town of Harney and

at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct but was a resident of Blitzen precinct.

J E Boyce voted in Blitzen precinct for the town of Harney and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct but was a resident of Harney precinct.

C C Kilburn voted in Burns precinct for the town of Harney and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct but was a resident of Silvies precinct.

J L Sitz voted in Crane Creek precinct for Silvies City and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct but was a resident of Saddle Butte precinct.

James Morris voted in Alvord precinct and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct but was a resident of Blitzen precinct.

E E Perrington voted in Drewsey precinct and at the time of voting was not a resident of said precinct but was a resident of Harney precinct.

8. That each and every one of the foregoing votes was and is illegal and should be deducted from the votes canvassed and counted by the canvassing board of Harney county as having been cast on the question of location of permanent county seat of said county, and that the evidence does not show that any other voted, counted, or canvassed by the canvassing board of said county, as having been cast upon the question of locations of permanent county seat was illegal or should be rejected.
