Buyers here have given the largest amounts for wool ever paid in any section, and in some instances have had a hard time to come out whole, but this was due to the fierce competition among the buyers and no one but themselves can be blamed. —Baker Democrat.

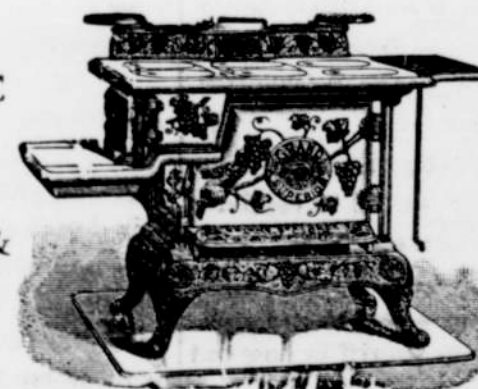
