SILVER LAKE, June 25.

ED. HERALD: With your permission I will give some of my conclusions drawn from my experience while wandering in Eastern Oregon, concerning the evidences I have seen of the glacial period or epoch. The glacier was here as far south as the 42nd parallel. We know this by the traces it has left in its track. When the ice was here its movement was slow. Many of them melted here, and the terminal moraine is positive evidence of a dying glacier. It has left its evidence in the rimrock in many places, and the distribution of those erratic blocks weighing tons in the dried up lakes, and the frontal and lateral moraines have deposited rocks that do not belong to our country, though some of them have not been brought a great distance. The former existence of these glaciers is proved not only by the presence of debris in the rocks, but by the frontal and lateral moraines which have been pushed forward in former days to the very outlet of the valleys and crumbled there.

Prof. Whitney asserted that the proof of glacial action was entirely wanting in California. If he had examined some portions of Eastern Oregon he certainly would have been convinced that they reached the Sierra Nevada Mountains. This question is something that has not been entirely solved on the Northwest coast, so far as books are concerned. I think that several men have written about Eastern and Southern Oregon that never saw it. But suffice it to say, that in my examination of the Oregon desert, and the lakes of this country, that I find evidence of the ice period. Silver Lake went dry in 1859, something that the native of the present day never before knew. I found large blocks of stone in its dry bed believing there was no other way for them to have got there except by the action of glaciers, and according to the geological history of the past, they will come again. Ice covers the soil of Northern Siberia, and it is a well known fact that the carcasses of the hairy elephant is found encased in it, and it is no doubt a fact that those glaciers are the remnants that extend further south.

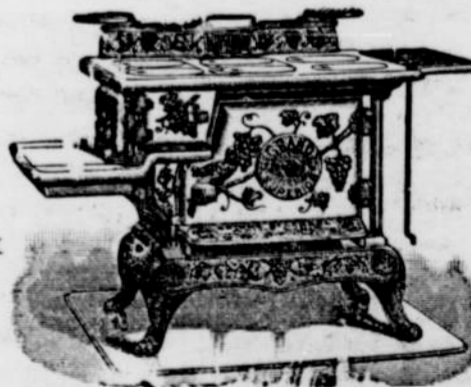
