BURNS Oregon, April 7th, '94. Pursuant to call by County Central Committee the Convention was called to order by J. L. Cross, Chairman, and the following proceedings were had:

M. Fitzgerald was elected temporary chairman by acclamation, and J. D. Daly was elected secretary by acclamation; when the following Committees were appointed:

Committee on Rules and organization; Ben Brown, R. J. McKinnon, D. Cawfield, I. L. Poujade and J. H. Phillips.

Committee on Credentials; W. F. Moffet, D. L. Shirk and F. G. Stauffer.

Committee on Platform and Resolutions; J. E. Roberts, J. D. Daly, W. J. Johnson, M. M. Whiteside and Chas. Zeigler.

Committee on Finance; W. R. McClure, Robt. Williams, J. P. Gearhart, A. Hembree and Wm. Altnow.

Upon motion the Convention adjourned to meet at half past 2 o'clock p. m.

Pursuant to motion the Convention reassembled and was called to order by the Chairman.

The Committee on Credentials made their report, and the same was adopted without dissent.

The Committee on Rules and Organization, reported, and recommended that M. Fitzgerald and J. D. Daly be elected permanent chairman and secretary, respectively, of said convention. Upon motion the same was adopted unanimously.

Upon motion W. J. Johnson, was called to act as assistant secretary of the convention, and H. E. Thompson and W. H. Hogan were appointed to act as tellers.

Nominations for County Officers were next declared in order, and Wm. Miller and T. J. Shields were placed in nomination for County Judge.

Wm. Miller having received a majority of all the votes cast, was declared the nominee of the Convention for the office of County Judge.

P. L. Shideler was declared the nominee of the convention, for County Clerk by acclamation.

W. E. Albersson, F. F. Stenger and Peter Clemens were placed in nomination for Sheriff. Upon the 2nd. Ballot, W. E. Albersson having received a majority of all the votes cast was declared the nominee of

the convention for Sheriff. S. W. Miller, was declared the nominee of the convention, for Assessor, by acclamation.

C. H. Voegtly, received the nomination for County Treasurer by acclamation.

L. N. Stallard, received the nomination for County Commissioner by acclamation.

Miss Rose Hembree, received the nomination for County School Superintendent, by acclamation.

T. A. McKinnon, received the nomination for County Surveyor by acclamation.

Lee Caldwell, was declared the nominee of the Convention for Coroner, by acclamation.

J. D. Daly, Ben Brown, C. F. McKinney and F. S. Rieder, were elected Delegates to the State Convention.

The following were selected as members of the Democratic County Central Committee for their respective precincts as follows: Burns, H. E. Thompson; Pine Creek, W. F. Moffett; Drewsey, M. F. Howard; Silvies, Walter Cross; Wild Horse, H. E. Layton; Harney, J. P. Rector; Lake, D. A. Cawfield; Curry, R. J. Williams; Saddle Butte, F. Crowley; Crane Creek, E. A. Stauffer; Alvord, John Davine; Diamond, F. S. Rieder; Happy Valley, J. P. Phillips; Poison Creek, Chas. Zeigler; Catlow, D. L. Saik.
