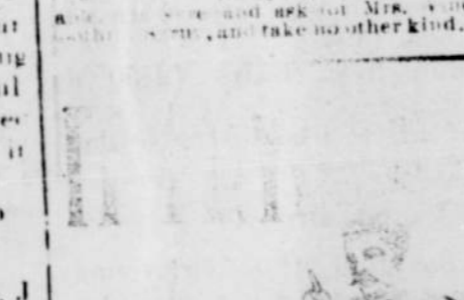


Illustration of a man sitting at a desk

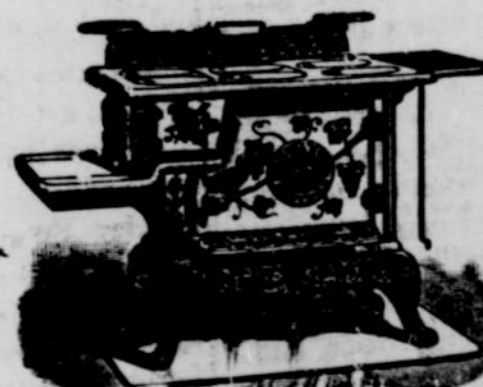
