 ED. HERALD: We are having heavy winds here in the last month, and three light snow storms. Snow fell the 8th, of Oct., 3 inches in depth on the 12th, two inches on the 15th, one and a half inches. The snow did not lay on the ground but a short time.

One thing I have noticed, as soon as frost came it killed the grass. No ice here yet of consequence. The weather generally fine except the wind.

Money is tolerably plenty here, most every one having some. The prime cause of money being in circulation is the police being stationed in districts all over the country, there are 200 stationed here at Fort Macleod, and this country only having a few settlers, all get a fair parcel of the circulating medium.

Most of parties go further north it is said not to be so windy and more timber but cold.

People here generally burn coal, it is worth, at Lethbridge, 30 miles from here, \$3.50 a ton, and here \$6.50.

The R. R. runs from here to Edmonton a distance of 400 hundred miles north.

The game here is scarce, there are many Prairie Chickens, and wolves are plenty. A wolf's scalp is worth \$5.00. The farmers have been plowing for two months. Grain is sowed here in the spring.
