The Burns Jockey Club will give four days racing, August 28, 29, 30 and 31, 1895.

FIRST DAY, AUG. 28. 1st, 4 mile dash, free for all,

2d, 4 mile dash for Harney county horses, 25 class, purse SECOND DAY, AUG. 29.

and repeat, two in three, free for all, purse

THIRD DAY, AUG. 30. 1st 1 mile dash, free for all,

2d, 600 yards dash, for Harney county horses that never run for public money, purse

FOURTH DVY, AUG. 31.

1st, 1 mile and repeat, two in three, free for all, purse 2d, 1 mile dash for Indian horses, Indian riders, entrance free, purse

Ten per cent entrance fee required in all races. Entries to be made with the secretary on or before 8 o'clock the evening before! each race. Five horses to enter and three to start in all races. First horse 75 per cent of purse, second horse 25 per cent. The races to be governed by the Blood Horse Association Rules.


