LITTLE ROCK, Nov. 2.—The cases against Fitzsimmons, Julian, Brady and Corbett were dismissed by the court this afternoon on an agreement that the men are to leave the state as soon as they can. Gov. Clarke says he has no intention of driving them out, but it will be a serious thing if the restraining order is violated.

This disposes of the last chance to pull off the fight. Brady will agree to nothing unless Julian's \$10,000 is up, and there are no signs of its being put up. Corbett and Brady will leave for New York soon.

John L. Rand, prosecuting attorney, is a candidate for congress. So is ex-Circuit Judge J. A. Fee, of Pendleton, J. B. Huntington, of Burns, and R. S. Anderson, of Baker. With these four adroit politicians struggling hard for the nomination, it is more than possible that Ellis will again be the republican standard bearer in the second district of Oregon. "That too many cooks spoil the broth," may be realized by the above coterie of aspirants.—Huntington Herald.
