His Corpse Guarded by a Dog.

Paris, Tex., Nov. 24—The Federal officials tonight received a telegram from Arthur City, Ind. T. giving information of a mysterious murder, or, possibly, series of murders. A boat was found adrift on Red River near that point this afternoon, unmanned and without a pilot. No living person was visible, a half famished dog being apparently the only occupant of the boat.

Several inhabitants put off in another boat to investigate. When they drew alongside a shocking sight met their gaze. A man lay upon the deck with his head almost severed from his body, and blood was spattered over the deck, indicating a desperate struggle. Owing to the rapid current and because the dog, which was famished to desperation, showed signs of fight, the boat could not be boarded. Points lower down the river were notified and the boat will be secured by morning. A force of Deputy Marshals has been rushed to the scene.

The man upon the deck had the appearance of having been dead for several days, and the investigating party reports that other bodies are on the boat beyond doubt.

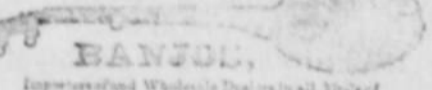
