To Conquer an Island.

Los Angeles, Dec. 7.—The Capitol published a story to the effect that a number of Los Angeles men have received a concession from the Mexican government to the island of Tiburon in the Gulf of California. The men are Colonel John Bradbury, J. Downey Harvey, Peter Martin and Walter S. Moore, all well known men.

Tiburon Island is inhabited by the Ceris Indians, a warlike race, said to be cannibals, and an expedition is being organized to kill them off and take possession of the island. A company of 300 men is being organized under the command of Colonel I. H. Polk. Each soldier is to receive \$250 and 100 acres of land after the island is conquered. The money for the expedition is being put up by Colonel Bradbury.

There are only about 40 male Ceris Indians, but they are said to be such valiant fighters that the Mexican government despaired of subduing them and has offered the island to Bradbury and his companions if they will undertake the work.

It is the intention of the Tiburon Conquest Company, as the new corporation is called, to establish a protectorate. It is stated that Mexico has consented to this. One of the objects the company has in view is to establish a great resort, and lines of steamers will be put on from Yuma and Guaymas.
