

Mysteriously Disappeared.

Sol Newcomer reports the mysterious disappearance from their home on upper Sinker creek, Owyhee county, Idaho, of Dick Thomas and wife, says the Elmore Bulletin. They lived 10 miles from the nearest neighbor, and had not been seen for over three weeks. The house was visited Sunday by some parties, who found the door closed but unlocked. On entering there was no one to be seen in the house, but everything seemed in perfect order. On the outside one dog was found dead and another almost dead from starvation. The horses and cattle were in the pasture and faring well. These parties returned to the lower settlements and reported the affair and yesterday a large number of people went out to search for the missing man and wife. Mr. Newcomer says their disappearance is a mystery to the people, and they fear Mr. and Mrs. Thomas have met with foul play and probably have been murdered.—Telegram April 28th.
