

It is plain to be seen, since the appearance of President Cleveland's last epistle on the gold standard, the gold element have taken new heart and will be at Chicago, in line, at the democratic convention. Whitney has postponed his trip to Europe in order to be present. Ex-Governor Russell of Massachusetts has signified his intention to be on hand to take part in the fight against silver. Both of these latter named gentlemen have expressed themselves as not in the race for presidential honors, but are purely actuated by their love of what they term "a sound currency."

Prior to the publication of the letter, already referred to, it seemed as if the gold wing of the party had virtually given up the fight, but this venture on the part of the head of the administration, has given this element new life. Undoubtedly this constituent part of the party will be in Chicago prepared, with a definite plan of action to stampede the silver delegates and carry the convention by storm. Whitney had his own way four years ago and confidently expects to carry through his plan of action this year. His success remains to be seen, but we think the democratic convention of this year have so far become enlightened regarding the outcome of New York's manipulators headed by Whitney as to ignore all or any part of a platform drafted by the smooth tongued New England politicians, and especially to nominate a man for the office of President, except he be a man of pronounced views on the silver question and one they know will carry out the wishes of the democratic party. This party has been and is today the friend of silver and the time has now come when it must speak through its delegates at the Chicago convention.

The gold plank in the St. Louis platform is already being deftly straddled by McKinley; and others.

The republicans will make their campaign in the eastern States on the platform and in the west on McKinley's past attitude towards silver.

Mark Hanna is today the whole thing, and should the country be unwise enough to elect McKinley he would be for four years the entire administration.

The McKinley road to the White House is a long one and a rough one and may become entirely blocked early in November.

Ex-Senator Ingalls says he will not stand upon the St. Louis platform in his effort to get returned to the Senate. He will use the old straddle.

Making Mark Hanna chairman of the republican National Committee, and of the executive committee seem to have been a waste of time. As long as Hanna is to be everything the committee should be abolished.

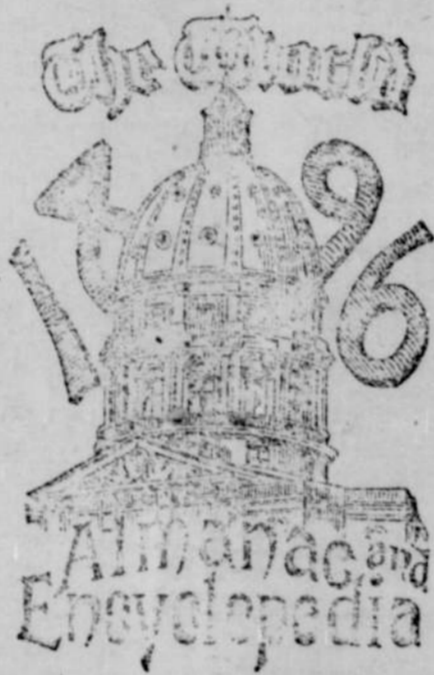
