Quietly and unostentatiously the Government commission is allotting to each Indian his share, segregating the valuable coal and asphalt lands, adjusting titles and preparing for the great influx of white men which is to follow.

When it is realized that at the last opening of the Kiowa-Comanche and the Wichita-Caddo reservation, a year ago, 165,865 persons registered their names in the lottery which had to dispose of only 13,000 homesteads, the extent of the efforts which will be made to secure land in this infinitely more valuable tract can be appreciated.
