

# GU golf team heads to district meet

## Nathan Gehley finishes 3rd at Buffalo Peaks

UNION – The Grant Union golf team finished its final round of regular season golf at Union's Buffalo Peaks Golf Course last week.

Prospector Nathan Gehley came in third with an 84, and Duane Stokes was 13th with a score of 89.

Two other Grant Union golfers were unable to attend due to testing at school. "The boys played well at Buffalo Peaks," said Grant Union head coach Ron Lundbom. "The two we did take played very well. Nathan got a bronze medal, and Duane had one bad hole that took him out of the top five, yet he still had another personal best."

More than 80 boys and girls from 12 schools competed in Union on the par 72 links course.

Nixyaawii won with a

score of 348, followed by Heppner with 352 and Vale, 356.

Low medalist was Logan Grieb of Heppner with 76, followed by Tiya Po Farrow of Nixyaawii with 81.

Grant Union travels to Pendleton on Sunday for the district golf meet.

A practice round Sunday will be followed by the first round at 10 a.m. Monday and second round at 9 a.m. Tuesday.

"We know what we have to do next week to get ready for districts," Lundbom said.

## Big, little fish get dropped into local ponds

GRANT COUNTY – Get those fishing poles in order and tackle boxes supplied –

fish stocking in Grant County

has begun. As of April 13-17, the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife stocked six ponds with legal-sized fish, including 5,200 at McNary Ponds and 1,000 at Seventh Street Pond.

The Trout Farm Pond will

be stocked with 1,000 legal-sized fish May 18-20, with more to be added June 1-5, including 400 trophy-sized.

Magone Lake will be stocked with 2,000 fish, including 1,000 trophy-sized, June 8-12.

The seedlings are mostly Ponderosa pine, but also some Douglas fir and western larch. The give-away is on a first

come, first served basis from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. through Friday, May 8, at the ODF, 415 Patterson Bridge Road.

The seedlings should be kept in a cool, moist environment until they are planted. They should be planted as soon as possible.


