This budget incorporates estimates from the State of Oregon based on an education budget of \$7.23 billion dollars for the 2015-17 biennium. The increase in general fund revenue is minimal. This year some areas of the budget were reduced to allow for annual payroll costs and roll-up increases. In addition, monies were allocated for the acquisition of much needed textbooks for the K-12 math program, and it was necessary to decrease expenses in other areas such as maintenance and buildings.

Malheur National Forest Central Malheur Allotment Grazing Reauthorization Decision

On Monday, May 11, 2015; Emigrant Creek District Ranger Christy A. Cheyne signed the Decision Notice for the Central Malheur Allotment Environmental Assessment. No objections were filed within the 45-day time period, therefore implementation of the decision may occur immediately.

The Decision continues authorization of livestock grazing on the Central Malheur Allotment using adaptive management strategies designed and implemented to meet Forest Plan standards and guidelines. Adaptive management principles would involve identifying management parameters designed to provide constrained flexibility, while ensuring that resource conditions are moving in the desired direction to produce the desired conditions.
